Fifty-eight die in shooting in Las Vegas 9 November, 2017

- 1 Forty per cent of Americans own a gun or live in a house where at least one person in the family owns a gun. For every 100 people in the United States, there are 90 guns. This is more than any other country.
- 2 Each of the 50 states in the United States has different laws but it is possible to buy a gun in all of them. In 36 states, you do not need a licence to buy a gun. You can walk into a gun shop and buy a handgun or a rifle. It is not always possible to buy automatic weapons but in some states, this is also possible.
- 3 On Sunday, 1 October, a man called Stephen Paddock was in a hotel room at the Mandalay Bay hotel in Las Vegas, Nevada. Next to the hotel, thousands of people were at a music festival. Paddock had several automatic weapons in his room on the 32nd floor of the hotel. At 10.05pm, Paddock started shooting at the people at the music festival. He continued shooting for almost ten minutes. When he finally stopped shooting, 58 people were dead and 489 were injured. Paddock was also dead. He killed himself before the police entered his hotel room.
- 4 Paddock arrived at the hotel on 25 September. He took more than ten suitcases into his hotel room during the days before the shooting. When police entered his hotel room, they found 22 rifles and one handgun. They still do not know why Paddock wanted to kill so many people. The shooting was the worst mass killing by one person in American history.
- 5 President Obama wanted to change the gun laws in the United States to make it more difficult for people to buy them. President Trump has not said that he wants to do this.
