2. Can you think of some instances where sharing a recording could be useful?

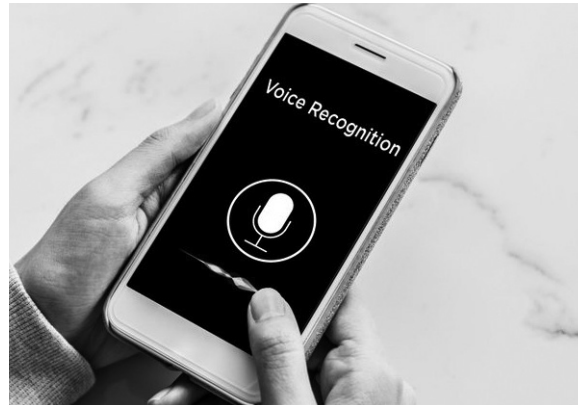
