A2 Services: The Great Outdoors?

Summary: The blog describes what glamping is and how it transformed the camping experience for a family.

Time: Approximately 30 minutes

Skills: Reading, Writing, Speaking

Language focus: Vocabulary

Materials needed: One worksheet per student

Reading

Have students read the text and answer the question.

Key:

Nowadays, camping can be more comfortable with larger tents, furniture, showers, hot and cold water, etc.

Vocabulary**Key:**

1. pitch
2. essential
3. shower
4. provide
5. glamorous

Comprehension**Key:**

1. It rained. It was so windy they nearly lost their tent.
2. beds, a shower, hot and cold water, a refrigerator
3. forests, mountains, a walking trail, a children's playground
4. swam in the river, sang songs around the fire, ate hot dogs, saw lots of animals
5. insect repellent

Thinking

Have students respond to the question in small group discussion or in writing.

Extension

Ask students to give you examples of what may be found in the area around a tent when going camping (rivers, lakes, mountains, fields, etc.). Ask the class to tell you if they have been camping or glamping and if these types of vacation are popular in their country.
