

Time: 30 minutes

Aim: to practise some countries in Europe and their flags

Key Vocabulary: France, United Kingdom, Portugal, Italy, Germany, Spain, Greece, Poland

Materials:

- A world map or a globe
- Worksheet
- Colour pencils or crayons

Warm-up

Students should be aware of different levels of self-identity, starting with the local neighbourhood or town, moving on to the city, the region, the country and the continent. They will also be able to name most of the countries in Europe.

- Write the names of the continents on the board. Ask, *Is your country part of Europe?* Have students come to the board and circle the continent they come from.

Completing the Worksheet

Activity 1

- Ask: What colours are in your national flag?
- Students colour the flags following the number key. Then, they label them using the word pool as reference. Check answers as a class.

Key: 1. France, 2. United Kingdom, 3. Portugal, 4. Italy, 5. Germany, 6. Spain, 7. Poland, 8. Greece

Activity 2

- Students label the map of Europe with the countries in the text box. They can add other country names they know.

Key: 1. United Kingdom, 2. Germany, 3. Poland, 4. Portugal, 5. France, 6. Greece; 7. Spain, 8. Italy

Project ideas

- Make a wall poster with flags from all the countries in Europe.
- Design a flag for the school or town.
- If there are any immigrant students in your class, have them find out more about the flag from their country of origin.
