Rental growth and euro's strength against dollar help a European street to top of list for first time in 34 years

- 1 Take away the names Fendi, Dior and Valentino, and Milan's Via Monte Napoleone looks like a fancy street in the capital, with a mix of vans, Vespas, Porsches, tourists and residents.
- 2 But the 350 metre-long street has just been named the world's most expensive shopping street. It beat New York's Fifth Avenue, London's New Bond Street and Paris's Champs-Élysées. It became the first European city to be #1 on the list in 34 years.
- The change shows how much rentals have grown over 30 per cent in the last two years. The euro's increase in value against the US dollar helped this.
- 4 Rent on the street can be as high as 20,000 euros (17,000 pounds sterling) a square metre annually. Rents on Fifth Avenue can reach 19,537 euros a square metre annually. Tsim Sha Tsui in Hong Kong came in at number four, with annual rent per square metre reaching 15,697 euros.
- Via Monte Napoleone is home to the world's biggest fashion brands. Italian brands Loro Piana and Tod's sit near Bottega Veneta and Versace. Gucci sits opposite Prada. All of them show at Milan fashion week, which adds more fashion excitement to the city.

- 6 Diletta Giorgolo from Italy Sotheby's International Realty said that prices stay very high because it is a special area and there aren't many places to rent.
- Other streets are doing well in terms of growth: Váci utca in Budapest, Omotesando in Tokyo, Midosuji in Osaka, the Design District in Miami and Indiranagar 100 Feet Road in Bengaluru.
- 8 Milan did not reach #1 in tourists though. Paris had about 50 million tourists last year, New York 60 million, Hong Kong 34 million, London 16 million and Milan 8.5 million.
- 9 Milan design week has grown in popularity recently and brings hundreds of thousands of design lovers to the city. JJ Martin is from LA but for the past 20 years has been in Milan with her brand La DoubleJ. "I'm thrilled for Milan for being in the news and being the centre of fashion, because it's so deserved it," she says.
- 10 Martin says she knows what makes the Milanese street so special: "You get a much better plate of pasta and glass of wine nearby."
